To use FlyNet[®], all you need is a laptop and a wireless LAN card conforming to IEEE 802.11b standard.

FlyNet[®] will gradually be introduced on Lufthansa long-haul flights through 2006.

Internet access – flat fee or by the minute

When using the Internet onboard Lufthansa, you have two price packages to choose from. **InternetFlight** – a flat fee for the duration of your flight (\$29.95 US) or **InternetMinutes** – an initial fee for the first 30 minutes (\$9.95 US) and a per minute fee thereafter (\$0.25). This service will be billed to the credit card you provide.



Create your profile

Before you travel or even while you're onboard, you will need to create a username and password to access the Internet. It's easy. Go to www.connexionbyboeing.com and click on "Sign-up for the Service". In four simple steps your profile is set-up and you're ready to surf above the clouds. You can update your profile at anytime.
